Program Description

The purpose of Teen Council is to empower and equip students to be advocates in their community and school to support the mission of Atlanta Ronald McDonald House Charities. If chosen to participate in the 2022-2023 Teen Council, students will be required to partake in four mandatory meetings, including orientation. Students will also be required to attend additional monthly virtual meetings and participate in initiatives and volunteer activities throughout the year.

- **All new applicants must provide one (1) letter of recommendation from a teacher, coach, or supervisor**
- **Who is eligible?**
 - **High School students from public and private schools within Atlanta. Students must be in grades 9-12 to be eligible for Teen Council.**

Program Commitments

- A one-year commitment with the possibility of continued service throughout high school.
- Active attendance and participation in meetings, volunteer activities, and fundraisers.
- Each member is required to complete all initiatives before deadlines.
- Must pay \$20 membership fee (t-shirt included).
- Raise awareness about ARMHC in school and community.
- Teen Council members must actively participate and communicate within their assigned Teen Council Group.
