Individual Volunteer Opportunity

Guest Services Volunteers maintain a set schedule of two-hour shifts weekly or biweekly. Guest Services volunteers must be at least 18 years old and commit to at least six months of service, subject to our needs.

Administrative Volunteer: Assist our volunteer management team with administrative tasks as needed. Tasks may include writing thank you notes, assembling event packets, etc.

House Greeter: Be the first to welcome a family, greet our visitors and thank a donor. House greeters are a welcoming face and provide information to our families and visitors. Tasks may include accepting donations, answering the doorbell, or the phone and giving tours.

House Refresher: This team of volunteers is important to providing a comfortable "home-away-from-home" for our families. House refreshers ensure everything is tidy and fresh. Tasks may include organizing our common areas, putting away donations, and restocking and organizing supplies.

Kitchen Volunteer: These volunteers help keep our kitchens organized and inviting for families and meal groups. Tasks may include cleaning out refrigerators, empty dishwashers, restocking kitchen supplies.

Meal Group Greeter: These volunteers are tasked with welcoming our meal groups. This role helps support meal volunteers with sign-in, getting acquainted with the kitchen, giving tours, etc.

Outdoor Volunteer: Weather permitting, these volunteers help keep our outdoor spaces clean and welcoming. If bad weather occurs, another volunteer opportunity may be substituted. Tasks may include: cleaning grilling areas, leaf blowing and cleaning plaques.

Pop Tab Volunteer: These volunteers sort through our pop tabs and get them ready to take to the recycle center — you get to use a custom, magnet Pop Tab sorter!
