Teen Council is available to high school students in grades 9-12 in the Atlanta area. To be considered, teens must submit an application, including one (1) letter of recommendation from a teacher, coach, or supervisor. The application must be fully completed by July 31. <u>Apply HERE</u>.

The purpose of Teen Council is to empower and equip students to be advocates in their community and school while supporting the mission of Atlanta Ronald McDonald House Charities. If chosen to participate in Teen Council, students will be partaking in mandatory meetings, service opportunities and fundraising initiatives throughout the school year.

Please note: Members must be self-motivated to complete their own assignments outside of meetings.

To ensure our Teen Council program is a success, we require our members to:

- Make a one-year commitment to our Teen Council, with the possibility of continued service throughout high school
- Attend 4/6 meetings or activities to fully complete the program
 - Fully completing the program guarantees the ability to receive letters of recommendation from ARMHC staff.
- Actively attend and participate in meetings, volunteer activities, and fundraisers (\$500 individual goal)
- Complete all initiatives before deadlines
- Raise awareness about ARMHC in their school and community
- Pay a \$20 membership fee (t-shirt included)
